

The Pamela Y. Holden Scholarship Fund

The Pamela Y. Holden Scholarship Fund was established in 1988 in memory of a beloved young adult member of Southlawn. The purpose of the scholarship fund is to provide financial assistance to young Christian African American students who are pursuing a baccalaureate degree from a college or university.

Criteria for Applying:

Applicants for scholarship awards must:

- Be an active member of a church.
- Be active in their local church, school and community.
- Have applied to or attending a 4 year college.
- Submit proof of matriculation to 4 year institution.
- Have a minimum of a “C” grade point average.
- Complete the scholarship application in its entirety.
- Submit original official school transcript.

The application process is open from April 28 – July 1. Applications will be available at the church office.

The Pamela Y. Holden Scholarship Fund is funded primarily by direct contributions from individuals and the fundraising activities of the Pamela Y. Holden Scholarship Committee.
